**SERVICE DESCRIPTION**Offers a program that makes monthly payments more affordable on a year-round basis for customers of regulated electric and/or gas service providers. Offers incentive credit and an arrearage credit when PIPP Plus payments are made on-time and in-full:

- Incentive Credit: Each time the client pays their required monthly payment on-time and in-full, the client no longer owes the rest of that month's billed amount (otherwise, this amount is added to the client's arrearages).

- Arrearage Credit: Provides a 1/24 credit toward any old debt when payments are made on-time and in-full (if the client makes full, on-time payments for 24 straight months, then all of the arrearages will be eliminated).

NOTE: This helps only regulated utilities.

INTAKE PROCEDURE If Applying for PIPP Plus for the First Time:

- Call Community Action Akron Summit's Energy Assistance Appointment line to schedule a phone appointment.

To Re-Verify:

- Call Community Action Akron Summit's Energy Assistance Appointment line to schedule a phone appointment, if desired. Or re-verify online at www.energyhelp.ohio.gov or by completing the Energy Assistance Programs Application and dropping it off or mailing it to Community Action Akron Summit's Akron location at 670 West Exchange Street. To obtain an application, call ODSA's toll-free Energy Assistance Programs line at 1-800-282-0880 or visit the website at www.energyhelp.ohio.gov.

#### To Re-Enroll:

- Customers who were previously on PIPP Plus, must pay the balance of the default (per utility) before they can be re-enrolled in the PIPP Plus program. Default includes ALL unpaid installment payments (even those due while the utility was off).
- Must re-verify information on a yearly basis to remain on the program. Re-verify by completing an Energy Assistance Programs Application and dropping it of or mailing it to Community Action Akron Summit's Akron location at 670 West Exchange Street.

FEESFree to apply. There are no deposits for PIPP Plus households. Minimum monthly payment is \$10 or:

- Natural gas: 6% of the client's monthly household income.
- Electric: 6% of the client's monthly household income.

- All-electric homes: 10% of the client's monthly household income.
- . The required documentation needed for HEAP can be:
- Dropped off at 670 West Exchange Street in Akron.
- Faxed to 330-313-3884.
- Uploaded if applying online at energyhelp.ohio.gov.

If applying for PIPP Plus for the first time: By phone appointment during office hours Monday through Friday from 8:00am to 5:00pm.

**SERVICE DESCRIPTION**Offers customers of Ohio Edison/FirstEnergy a free Energy Conservation Kit which includes LED light bulbs in various wattages, a three-way compact fluorescent light bulb, LED night lights, a furnace filter whistle and additional energy-saving components. Customers with electric water heaters may be eligible to receive an additional device to help conserve water, such as a low-flow shower head or a faucet aerator.

INTAKE PROCEDUREAs of 05.27.2021, customers can sign up to receive an Energy Conservation Kit by enrolling online at www.ohioenergykit.com or by calling Ohio Edison's vendor, Power Direct Energy, at 1-888-793-6768. If customers received an email or postcard, they can use the 7-digit invitation code to enroll. Customers without an invitation code will need to provide their 12-digit account number, which can be found on the upper right hand corner of their electric bill.

**FEES**No additional cost. The costs related to Ohio Edison's energy efficiency programs are reflected in all customers' bills (just as the cost of utility poles, transformers, wires and bucket trucks are included in customer bills).

**ELIGIBILITY**Serves Ohio Edison residential customers with their 12-digit Ohio Edison account number or a 7-digit invitation code. Limit of 1 Energy Conservation Kit per residential account.

**HOURS**As of 05.27.2021, available online 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. Available by phone Monday to Friday from 9:00am to 6:00pm and Saturday from 10:00am to 1:00pm.
